Local connection criteria

Where affordable homes are part of a new build development of properties the Local Connection Criteria is determined during the planning process and is applicable to people wanting to purchase a new home on that development.

Allocation	Allocation of the affordable dwellings for those who meet the residency requirement and the Local Connection requirement below.
Local connection	Qualifying Person means persons who fall into at least one of the following categories:-
Conficction	(a) tenants of Registered Providers;
	(b) people who are on the Council's housing register;
	(c) people who cannot afford their own home but who are employed by business or public organisations within the County of Somerset or any adjoining County;
	(d) key workers in the public sector such as teachers nurses and police officers provided that high house prices are affecting recruitment and retention; or
	(e) first time buyers who could not otherwise afford to buy a house
	Applicants must meet one of the below categories:
	Persons who have a minimum of one year residence within the Parish of Cheddar
	• Persons who are employed in the Parish of Cheddar. The employment must be consistent paid employment for a minimum of the last 3 months with an average of 16 hours a week
	• Persons who have an essential need to live close to another person within the Parish of Cheddar, who has lived continuously in the Parish of Cheddar for a minimum of one year
	In the event that a property can not be sold to a person under the above categories, the property will be sold to any other Qualifying Person, free from the local connection criteria
